

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Our construction defect repairs will resume on August 12th – the scope of work is limited to the HVAC decks and front deck (where bronze doors are located). The majority of the repairs will not be visible, however, they impact the use of air conditioning. Existing air conditioning units will be removed starting August 12th with construction beginning August 19th. Windows will open Friday afternoons and be closed Sunday evenings until the completion of project which is expected to be 6-8 weeks. You may wonder why would this project start at the peak of our hot weather - we have been actively working to get this project started since April, however, we cannot wait until the fall and risk rain, as decks/roofs that would expose building interiors will be opened up/removed. Thank you for your patience during this project— what we hope is our final phase of repairing construction defects.
